JOURNEY BOX INFORMATION

What is a Journey Box?

A Journey Box is a storage box that contains all the materials necessary to teach about a natural resource concept. (SOL aligned lesson plan, hand-outs, manipulatives)

Journey Box Topics: Watersheds, Water Cycle and Wetlands
Adapted to several grade levels.

How does it work?

Educators in Amelia, Nottoway and Prince Edward Counties can borrow a Journey Box to complete with their students. Or they can request Kelly Atkinson, the Piedmont Education Coordinator, bring and present in the classroom. After the Journey is completed, educators are responsible for cleaning and packing up the supplies for return within 2 weeks.

Do I need to buy any supplies to complete the lesson activity?

No, all materials are included. However, you may need to make copies for your class (master copy included).

Do I need to pick the box up?

You can come by the District office to retrieve the box and its contents if that is convenient or Kelly is available to deliver the box to you.

How long can I keep the box?

We ask that you return the box (with all the unused contents) within 2 weeks of borrowing date.
