A FACT: Envirothon can be a lot on top of all your other work but it

doesn't have to be. Here are some tips to help you and your team be prepared!

- 1. If you haven't already, find your team (ask students with an interest in the outdoors).
 - (2-3 alternates can come to competition). All are welcome at the workshop.
- 2. Have each member of your team identify their topic of interest (see blue oval). If you have more than 5 interested students, pair them up to learn the content together. Younger students can learn now to be on a future team!
- 3. Team members begin learning about their topic using the links provided on our website.
- 4. Coaches read scenario and think about oral presentation
