College Scholarship Application & Guidelines— For High School Seniors

Due to Piedmont SWCD no later than Tuesday, March 19, 2024

<u>Purpose</u>: To promote the education of Virginia citizens in technical fields with natural resource conservation and environmental protection.

To give financial support to students majoring in or showing a strong desire to major in a course curriculum related to natural resource conservation and/or environmental studies.

Qualifications: Individual applicants must be Virginia residents and full-time students enrolled in or who have applied to a college freshman level curriculum. Applicants shall document a class ranking in the top 20% of his or her graduating class or a 3.0 or greater Grade Point Average or appropriate equivalent of individual scholastic achievement. The applicant's most recent official school transcript must accompany the application. Transcripts should be printed by the school and in a sealed envelope. Applicants shall demonstrate active interest in conservation.

One-year scholarships will be awarded to students with a permanent residence in Amelia, Nottoway and Prince Edward County. Previous applicants will need to reapply each year.

<u>Amount Awarded</u>: Three \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded to students with a permanent residence in Amelia, Nottoway and Prince Edward Counties. A check will be issued directly to the selected institution of higher education on behalf of the student. <u>Awardees must provide Piedmont SWCD a copy of college enrollement letter or other documentation that has the school's name, student's name and identification number (need this to ensure funds go into the correct account) and a date.</u>
