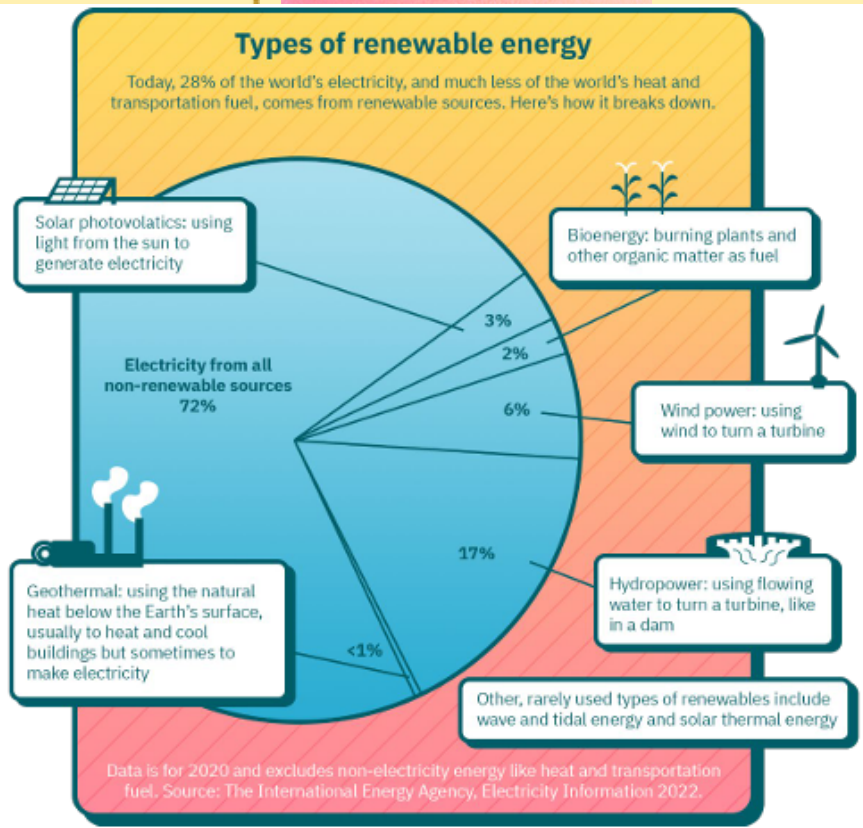
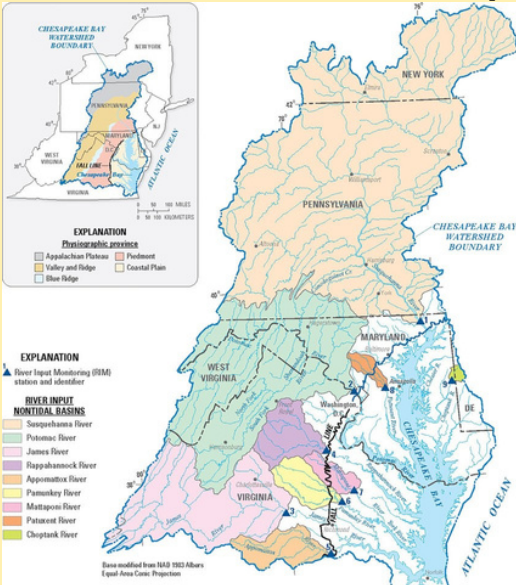

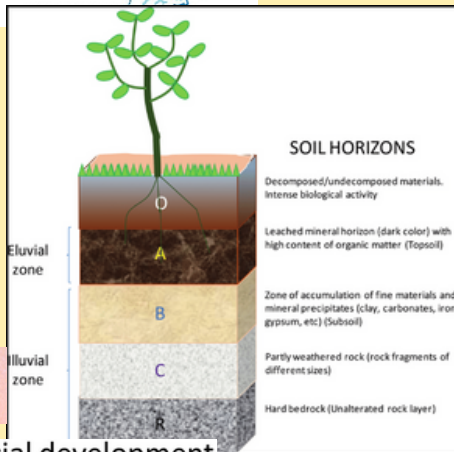

| 2. Open eyes, hair or down | 3. Cannot walk or fly |
| 3. Active or mobile | 4. Confined to nest or burrow |
| 4. Not confined to nests | 5. Energy goes into parental care after birth |
| 5. Energy goes into prenatal development | |
