College Scholarship Application & Guidelines— For Current College Students

Due to Piedmont SWCD no later than Tuesday, March 11, 2025

Purpose: To promote the education of Virginia citizens in technical fields with natural resource conservation and environmental protection.

To give financial support to students majoring in or showing a strong desire to major in a course curriculum related to natural resource conservation and/or environmental studies.

Qualifications: *Individual applicants must be Virginia residents and full-time students enrolled in college.* Applicants shall have 3.0 or greater Grade Point Average. Applicants shall demonstrate active interest in conservation. **The applicant's most recent official school transcript must accompany the application.** Transcripts can be emailed directly from the school registrar.

A one-year scholarship will be awarded to a student with a permanent residence in Amelia, Nottoway or Prince Edward County. Previous applicants will need to reapply each year.

Amount Awarded: One \$2,000 scholarship will be given to students with a permanent residence in Amelia, Nottoway or Prince Edward County. A check will be issued directly to the selected institution of higher education on behalf of the student. Awardees must provide Piedmont SWCD a proof of enrollment in the form of a schedule or other documentation that states the school's name, date, student's name and identification number.
