

SCHOOL YEAR MONTHLY GUIDE Topic: Reuse/repurpose Learn: What does it mean to repurpose? Action: Reuse what you can, repurpose where appropriate. Example: make you own notepad using scrap paper.
Conservation Matters! SCHOOL YEAR MONTHLY GUIDE Topic: Don't Litter Learn: What is litter? Why is litter a problem? Action: Do your part and don't litter. Pick up litter if you see it and put it in a trash can.	DONE! One thing I learned:	Conservation Matters! SCHOOL YEAR MONTHLY GUIDE Topic: Reduce Household Trash Learn: Where does your trash go? Action: Talk to you family members and come up with a plan to reduce the trash you produce. Example: take groceries home in a reuseable bag; don't use disposable plates, cups and utensils

Action: Be aware and active in reducing the waste you produce. Example: only take the amount of food you can eat; buy things with less packaging; make your own wrapping paper	DONE!
